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| 8.5 | DUVEL "The Devil". Deceptively strong pale golden beer. Brewed by Moortgat in the village of Breendonk. | £5.65 |
| 10.0 | MAREDOUS Tripel. Strong, clean tasting classic Belgian style of beer produced by the Moortgat family brewers | £6.25 |
| 5.0 | HOEGAARDEN WIT (white) beer. Made to an old recipe using 45% wheat, 5% oats, and 50% barley. Light & refreshing. Characteristic white cloudiness. | £4.55 |
| 7.0 | RED CHIMAY. Full copper colour. Soft palate. Very fruity. | £4.95 |
| 8.0 | WHITE CHIMAY. Trappist beer. Pale colour, very dry and hoppy. | £5.25 |
| 9.0 | BLUE CHIMAY "Vintage dated". Superb Trappist beer from Belgium's Largest Monastery Brewery at the Abbey of Notre Dame. | £5.95 |
| 9.5 | ST. BERNARDUS ABT. Full-bodied, yeasty & satisfying. Brewed, in Watou, under license from the smallest of Belgium's Abbey breweries (St.Sixtus). | £7.25 |
| 6.2 | ORVAL Deliciously bitter, distinctively-hopped beer in a skittle-shaped bottle, brewed by the Trappist fathers at Villers-devant-Orval. Another Belgian classic. | £4.95 |
| 7.0 | RODENBACH GRAND CRU. 'Red Beer' from Flanders. The colour comes from the use of Vienna malts and ageing for up to two years in untreated oak casks. Tart and to some a rather sour flavour A "world classic" says The Beer Hunter! | £6.25 |
| 8.5 | Pauwel KWAK "The Coachman's beer" from Bosteel's brewery in Buggenhout. Served in the world's most extravagant beer glass! | £5.45 |
| 6.0 | FRANK BOON GUEUZE Almost Champagne like, dry & fruity. (37.5cl) LAMBIC BEER. Spontaneously fermented by wild yeasts in the Senne Valley, Belgium | £7.25 |
| 5.0 | BACCHUS – RASPBERRY BEER a premium fruit beer from Van Honebrouck a family owned brewery in West Flanders | £7.95 |
| 5.8 | BACCHUS – CHERRY BEER also from Van Honebrouck | £7.95 |
